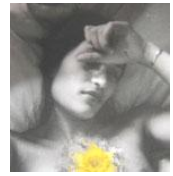


Glorious

Glorious is the third in a trilogy of large-scale pieces by Rajni Shah Projects, and is being researched and developed as an innovative piece of musical theatre. The company plans to use this genre to facilitate engagement with artists, communities and audiences in each of ten locations across the UK.

From a full blown orchestra to a small folk band, in each location the score will be adapted and arranged by composers Ben and Max Ringham in collaboration with musical director Suzie Shrubbs to suit the instruments available, effectively re-imagining the work each time it's performed.

The schedule has yet to be confirmed in detail but there will be rehearsals in the venue leading up to the performance and our Musical Director Suzie Shrubbs will be available to rehearse with you during your normal rehearsal time.

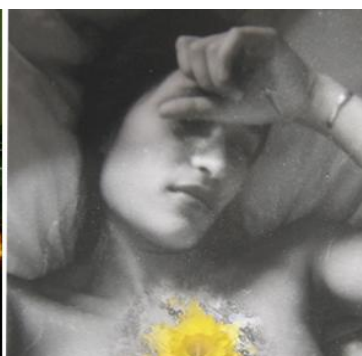
