



## **CALL FOR PERFORMERS: Rajni Shah's *Glorious* at Inbetween Time**

Artist Rajni Shah is looking for up to six performers to take part in a performance of 'Glorious Act One' at the Inbetween Time Festival in Bristol in early December 2010.

*Glorious* is a haunting and unusual new musical that will be completely reinvented for every location, as members of the local community work with the company to create this event. *Glorious* is a response to the sense of 'not knowing' that pervades Europe today - both the fear and the space for hope that has emerged as a result of our increased awareness of climate change, shifts in border policies, and the dramatic impact of the financial collapse.

Individuals will get a chance to work with Rajni and company devising short performances from autobiographical material, which they will then perform alongside the company during the festival. Participants do not need to have prior performance experience, but need to be comfortable with the idea of performing on stage in a professional setting.

### **How to apply**

Dates for rehearsals are yet to be confirmed, but participants will need to be available to work with the company in Bristol on:

- 1 full day in late November
- 3 days (part time) between November 30th and December 5th, including a performance
